HALF DAY

Social Services Area (Figini and Pollini)

A complex of buildings built at the end of the 1950s to house the infirmary and the cultural center. The former library can be visited inside with museum

Nursery and Public Housing of Borgo Olivetti (Figini and Pollini)

Buildings built around 1940, the already renovated part of the nursery (garden classroom) can be visited inside

In the two-year period 2025-26 due to the planned renovation works, visits can only be carried out with the prior consent of the Works Management

West Residential Unit (Talponia) (Gabetti and D'Isola)

Building dating back to 1971 used as a guesthouse, can also be visited inside (duplex and simplex)

Castellamonte residential district

Residential area built between the 1940s and 1950s. Can only be visited outside

Office Building (Fiocchi, Bernasconi, Nizzoli)

Building built at the beginning of the 1960s, it housed the company's top management. The monumental staircase, guesthouse and conference room can be visited internally

PAY ATTENTION:

Although work is underway to remove them, some buildings have architectural barriers and are not suitable for people with reduced mobility.

Since buildings are private property, the access is allowed only with owners authorization.
